

# BLME finances an apartment development in prime Liverpool location

**London, 16 May** – Bank of London and The Middle East plc finances an apartment development for £18.04 million for KDM Hurst Street Limited & KDM Tabley Street Limited headed by Liverpool based property entrepreneur Ming Yeung of YPG Group of Companies.

The development consists of 204 apartments and is located on Tabley Street, Liverpool perfectly positioned in the Baltic Triangle, the fastest growing area of the city and Liverpool's creative hub. The Tabley Street apartments are within walking distance of Liverpool Lime Street, the Albert Dock, and the Echo Arena as well as Liverpool One shopping centre.
